- ✓ Pied-billed Grebe –not uncommon for us, but we like them
 - ✓ Eared Grebe
 - ✓ Western Grebe
 - ✓ Clark's Grebe
 - ✓ American White Pelican
 - ✗ White-faced Ibis – Only seen in Texas last year
 - ✓ Tundra Swan
 - ✓ Cinnamon Teal – Only seen twice
 - ✓ Canvasback
 - ✓ Redhead
 - ✓ Ring-necked Duck
 - ✓ Any hawk, eagle or falcon (Merlin, Peregrine, American Kestrel) but especially
 - ✗ Northern Goshawk (only seen three times, but once there were three)
 - ✗ Ferruginous Hawk (only seen once)
 - ✓ Golden Eagle
 - ✗ Prairie Falcon (only seen once)
- All partridges, chickens, quails – haven't seen them much. The following would be lifers
- ✗ Gray Partridge
 - ✓ Greater Sage Grouse
 - ✓ Gunnison Sage Grouse
 - ✗ White-tailed Ptarmigan
 - ✗ Sharp-tailed Grouse

- ✓ Any Rail – Virginia heard
- ✓ Black-necked Stilt – not unusual for us, but we like them
- ✓ American Avocet – not a rarity, but nice
- Sandpipers – all are nice, especially would like – Western by Joan

- ✓ California Gull – Have to see your state bird
- ✓ White-winged Dove

- Any owl – the following would be lifers
- ✓ Western Screech-Owl

- ✗ Spotted Owl
- ✓ Burrowing Owl
- ✓ Great Horned Owl
- ✗ Common Poorwill – would be a lifer
- ✓ ✓ Lewis's Woodpecker – would be lifer
- ✓ Acorn Woodpecker
- ✗ Red-naped Sapsucker
- ✗ Ladder-backed Woodpecker

- ✗ Three-toed Woodpecker – would be lifer
- ✓ Northern Flicker (if Red-shafted)

- ✓ Pygmy Nuthatch – only seen three times
- ✓ ✓ Any wren – **Rock Wren, Canyon Wren**
- ✗ American Dipper
- ✗ Black-tailed Gnatcatcher
- ✓ Western Bluebird
- ✓ Mountain Bluebird
- ✓ Townsend's Solitaire (although we got one in Connecticut last week)

- ✓ Sage Thrasher – only seen twice
- ✗ Crissal Thrasher – only seen once
- ✗ Le Conte's Thrasher – would be lifer
- ✗ Phainopepla
- ✓ Loggerhead Shrike
- Any warbler – especially
- ✗ Orange-crowned Warbler
- ✗ Townsend's Warbler
- ✓ Spotted Towhee – even though we just got one in Connecticut
- ✗ Abert's Towhee – only seen once
- ✗ Rufous-crowned Sparrow – only seen three times
- ✗ Brewer's Sparrow – would be a lifer
- ✗ Lark Sparrow
- ✗ Sage Sparrow – seen only once
- ✓ Lincoln's Sparrow
- ✗ Dark-eyed Junco (if other than Slate-colored)
- ✓ Western Meadowlark
- ✓ Yellow-headed Blackbird
- ✓ Brewer's Blackbird
- ✓ ✓ All Rosy Finches – would be lifers – Gray-crowned, Black
- ✗ Pine Grosbeak – would be lifer
- ✓ Cassin's Finch – only seen once
- ✓ Red Crossbill – only seen three times
- ✓ Pine Siskin
- ✗ Lesser Goldfinch
